The following draft of certain rules, which it is proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Ancient Monuments Preservation Act, 1904 (VII of 1904), is published as required by section 20 (2) of the Act for the information of persons likely to be affected thereby, and notice is given that the draft will be taken into consideration by the Governor in Council on or after the 12th day of April 1909.</p> <p>2. Any objection or suggestion which may be sent to the Secretary to Government, Gernral Department, by any person with respect to the draft will be considered by the Governor in Council.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Draft Direction</p> <p>1.
